TITLE Localization of Cohomological Induction

ABSTRACT Cohomological induction is defined for (\mathfrak{g}, K) -modules in an algebraic way and construct important representations such as (Harish-Chandra modules of) discrete series representations, principal series representations and Zuckerman's modules of semisimple Lie groups. Hecht, Milicic, Schmid, and Wolf proved that modules induced from one-dimensional representations of Borel subalgebra can be realized as *D*-modules on the flag variety. In this talk, we show a similar result for modules induced from more general representations.
