- TITLE A characterization of non-tube type Hermitian symmetric spaces by visible actions (Japanese)
- ABSTRACT We consider a non-symmetric complex Stein manifold D which is realized as a line bundle over the complexification of a noncompact irreducible Hermitian symmetric space G/K. In this talk, we will explain that the compact group action on D is strongly visible in the sense of Toshiyuki Kobayashi if and only if G/K is of non-tube type. In particular, we focus on our construction of slice which meets every orbit in D from the viewpoint of group theory, namely, we find an A-part of a generalized Cartan decomposition for homogeneous space D. We note that our choice of A-part is an abelian.
