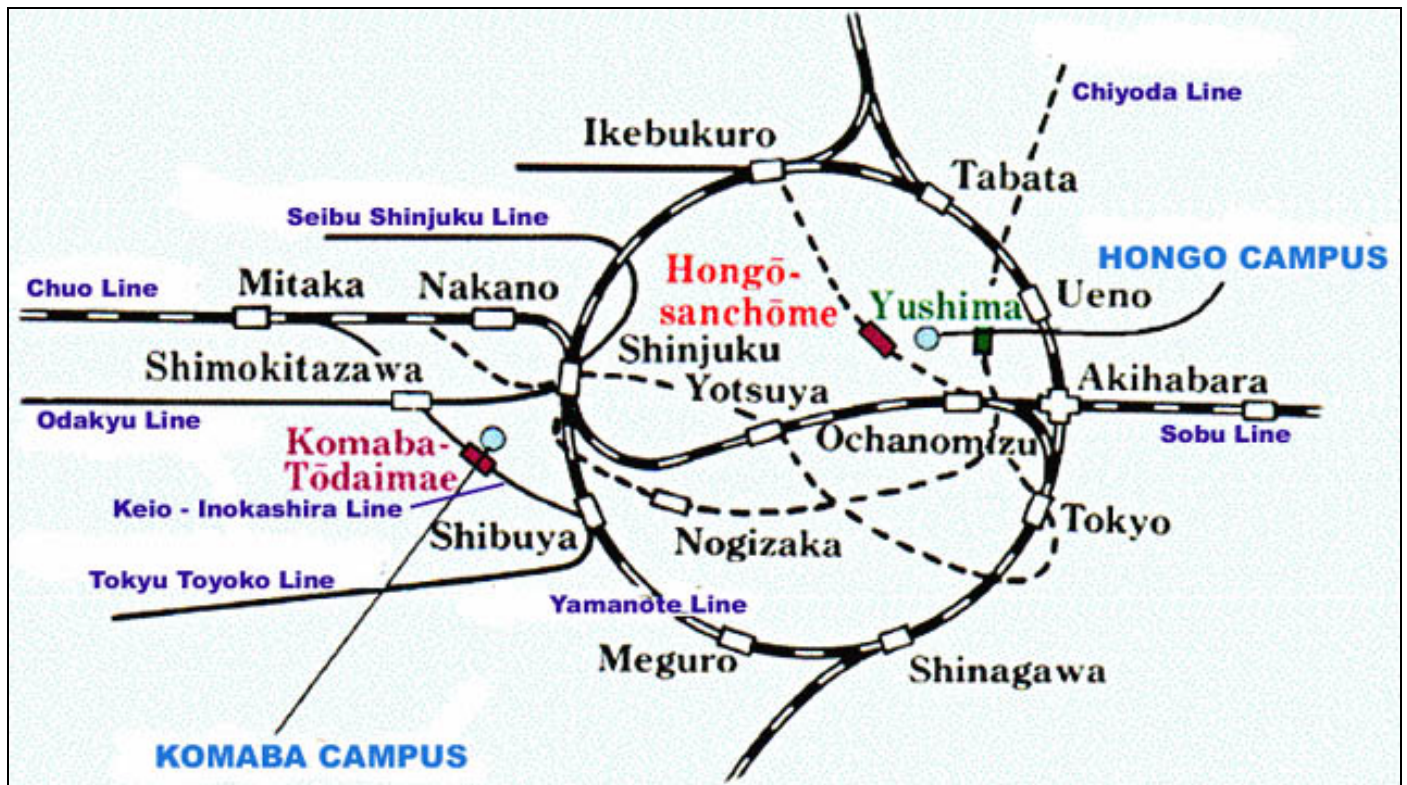


# Welcome to Graduate School of Mathematical Sciences, the University of Tokyo!

The University of Tokyo has several campuses. Our institute is in **Komaba Campus** near **Shibuya** area. You go to **Shibuya** first to get to our campus.



## < from Haneda Airport to Shibuya >

There are 3 ways.

### By bus

The easiest way is to take **Limousine Bus** to **Shibuya**. (But sometimes there is a traffic jam.) Get off at **Shibuya Excel Hotel Tokyu**. (40-65minutes/ 1,000 yen)

### By train 1

Take **Tokyo Monorail** to **Hamamatsucho**, then take **JR Yamanote line** to **Shibuya**. (about 50 minutes/ 660 yen) <http://www.tokyo-monorail.co.jp/english/>

### By train 2

Take **Keikyu line** to **Shinagawa**, then take **JR Yamanote line** to **Shibuya**. (about 50 minutes/ 560yen) <http://www.haneda-tokyo-access.com/en/sights/shibuya/>

## <from Shibuya to the venue>

### By train

Take a local train of **Keio-Inokashira line** to **Komaba-Todaimae**. (Shibuya Station of Keio -Inokashira line is on the second floor of Shibuya Mark City Building.) It is two stops from **Shibuya**. Please take a train carefully: only local trains stop at **our place**. Komaba campus is in front of the station and the venue is the Auditorium at Graduate School of Mathematical Sciences Bldg.
